## Is Your Child Having Trouble Focusing On What You Say and/or Is Having Trouble Following Directions....

- Play Simon Says
- Read to your child and discuss what you have read
- Whisper to your child
- Encourage a listening posture when you talk to your child
- Have your child repeat any instruction that you give Give your child a verbal list of three to four things to do.... Have your child repeat this list.... Then have your child do what you have instructed...
- With your child's eyes closed, have him/her tell you how many times you clapped your hands or bounced the ball....
- Describe your action to your child as you do things
- Play 20 questions
- Verbalize the organization of tasks and steps in problem solving.
- Allow your child to verbalize his/her actions out loud while he/she works if it helps him/her concentrate....
