

Homework Study Sheet for: October 1-5



Bible Lesson and Memory Verse:

"Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and he will give you everything you need." Luke 12:31

We are reading stories from the Old Testament.

Math:

Parents, please continue to help us with our numbers. By now we should know what the numbers 1-10 look like. And we should be able to write these numbers. Start with numbers 1-5 and work up. We need to be able to do one to one correspondence using these numbers. (counting objects like: blocks, pennies, toothpicks, etc.) We also need to continue learning the days of the week and the months of the year in and out of order. . . learning the words before, after, and in-between. Remember to have your child follow through on 2-3 step instructions. For example: Put on your coat and get your backpack then meet me at the front door.

Language Arts:

We are studying the letter "D". It's sound is made by putting the tip of your tongue at the roof of your mouth and as you voice the sound you open your mouth slightly. Have your child feel his/her throat and mouth as she/he sounds the letter "D". Look for things around the house that begin with this letter. Go over the letters we have studied: S,T,B,F,R. Make sure your child can identify these, make their sound and write them. These are "good guy" letters because they say their sound. Please continue to have your child write his/her name. "Rr" is a hard sound for some of us. Please really practice this sound. WE DO NOT KNOW HOW TO RHYME! Please, please work on this. Read poetry or books with rhyme and talk about which words rhyme.

Science and Social Studies:

We will continue our unit on growth: plant growth and harvest.
