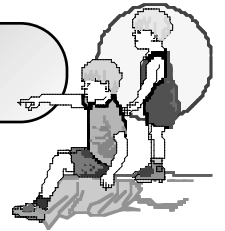


# MGA Kindergarten Connections



## Homework Study Sheet for January 7-11

### Bible lesson and Memory Verse:

“Be patient with everyone.” 1 Thessalonians 5:14

We are continuing in our study of the lives of Old Testament Leaders.....

**Math:** Continue to count objects around the house (one to one correspondence). Put the items into categories and classify them. Point out the concept of same and different..... Distinguish between left, right, top, bottom, in the middle, up, down, before, after, in between, first, last, etc..... Use ordinal numbers like first, second, third, etc. Start learning the names and be able to identify coins... a penny, nickel, dime, quarter, and half a dollar.

Use coins and other objects around the house to do simple addition and subtraction. As you are with your child doing errands, etc. show him/her how we use math in our everyday lives.....

**Language Arts:** Continue to work on the “good guy” letters at home.... Identifying by sight and sound and writing them... upper and lower case.... **Ss, Tt, Bb, Ff, Pp, Rr, Dd, Jj, Kk, Ll, Mm, Nn, Vv, Xx, Zz**... We are starting our “bad guy” letters. The first one is the letter “Hh”. It’s sound is made by making an “unvoiced” soft sound. The tongue is in a relaxed position. Your mouth is slightly open as you breath the sound out. Have your child feel his/her throat and mouth as she/he sounds the letter “Hh”. Does a lot of air come out of your mouth? Does your throat vibrate? Look the things around the house that begin with this letter. Please continue to write at home. Write your name.... first and last name. Be sure to hold the pencil correctly.... position the paper correctly, and **USE CAPITAL LETTERS ONLY WHEN NEEDED**...

Please work on the lower case letter “a”. Do not start forming the letter at the bottom. Many of the children are starting their letters at the bottom.

Continue learning your **phone number, address, and birthdate**. Please keep practicing how to **tie your shoes**.

**PLEASE:** We will be starting our Flat Stanley Activity. This is a fun activity to be involved with. Please help your child with it. He/she will be so excited when they receive mail from their family or friends and when they share these letters, pictures, etc. with their class. Thank you!
