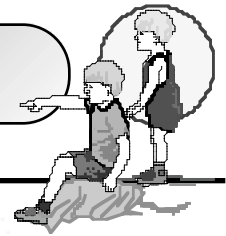


MGA Kindergarten Connections



Homework Study Sheet for: January 21-25

Bible Lesson and Memory Verse:

“God blessed the seventh day and made it holy.” Genesis 2:3

We continue learning about the life of Old Testament leaders..

Math:

Discuss how everyday objects fit into categories and classify them. Work on simple addition and subtraction using objects as manipulatives. Talk about telling time by the hour. Work with money so that your child can identify a penny, nickel, dime, quarter, half dollar, and dollar bill.

Reading:

Parents, **Continue working on the gross and fine motor skill ideas I sent home.** We are studying our We are studying the letter “Aa”. The short sound of “a” is produced with a relatively flat tongue, the mouth opened wide and the jaw far down as you would when saying a word like “atom”. Have your child feel his/her throat and mouth as she/he sounds the letter “Aa”. Does a lot of air come out of your mouth? Does your throat vibrate? The letter “Aa” also says its name. This sound is made by spreading the corners of your lips and lifting your tongue as you would when saying “ate”. You can go over different words using the long and the short sound of this letter. Look for things around the house that begin with the letter “Aa”. Go over the letters we have studied:

Ss, Tt, Bb, Ff, Pp, Rr, Dd, Jj, Kk, Ll, Mm, Nn, Vv, Xx, Zz, Hh, Cc, and Aa. Make sure your child can **identify these and make their sound.** Have your child **write these letters using the capital and lower case.** Students, please **continue to practice writing your name.** Also **remember to write slowly so that the Letters are formed correctly.** And Remember we only use a capital at the beginning of our first, middle, and last name. We are having trouble making our lower case “A”. Please help us by practicing at home with your child.

Start putting sounds together: at words, ad words, an words, etc. than go on with ed, en, et, etc., it, in, id, etc., od, ot, on, etc., ut, un, ud, etc.....

Many of us still do not know our **address, phone number, and birth date.** Let's keep practising. Many of us can not **tie our shoes!! Please keep practicing these at home.... These are homework assignments. Thank you....**
