# SOPHOMORE BIBLE REPORTS

### 10 BIBLE

- I. <u>Minimum</u> length 1000 words (This will be at least 3 pages double spaced) Less than 1000 words will not be accepted.
- II. You must include the following in your report:
  - A. I. Historical Background. Describe time of the person you are researching.
  - B. II. Background of the individual. Date of birth, death, family etc.
  - C. **III. Contributions**. Describe the contributions made toward the development of the church.
  - D. **IV. Interesting Stories.** Include incidents you find most interesting. However, do not make your entire paper a quotation from sources.
  - E. **V. Unique qualities.** List qualities and experiences that made the person into what he became.
  - F. **VI. Conclusion**. A summary of your paper.
- III. Bibliography due on **February 11**, **2008**. This needs to be typed and in **MLA** Format.
- IV. No Rough draft the final is due **February 28, 2008** (50 points). Remember to include the bibliography and quotes. You must use the MLA English department format.
- V. Report must be typed. (Use your computer so it will be easier to make corrections)
- VI. Include the following in your report:
  - A. No title page- use the English department MLA format.
  - B. Content of at least 1000 words less than 1000 words will not be accepted.
  - D. Bibliography(Use at least three sources See MLA Research Paper Format)
  - E. No folder, just staple the pages together

- VII. All final reports are due by **February 28, 2008**. (100 points)
  - A. Due also on this day are the following:
    - 1. Quiz typed out not just part of your power point.
    - 2. The "Power Point" presentation that will be used for your presentation.

      The Power Point presentation needs to be loaded on the computer in the back of the classroom and checked to make sure it works.
    - 3. The "Learning Activity". This needs to be typed and ready to hand out.

### VIII. Verbal presentation of your report - 100 points

 Audio/visual (Power Point - video etc.) 5 points each	50 points
 Quiz - The quiz should be <b>typed out</b> and ready to give at the end of your presentation. Your score based on how well Your activity covers the lesson - not on how easy it is.	20 points
 Learning activity about your subject - game, project, crossword, puzzle, fill in blank, etc. make it valid for the lesson.	15 points
 The quiz should be graded and scores recorded on a score Sheet. Then pass the quiz back to the students.	15 points
